# Minutes of the meeting of the Empowered Committee held on 22nd February 2024 (Thursday) at 04.30 P.M in the Conference Hall of Finance Department under the Chairmanship of Principal Secretary, Finance for grant of permission for filling up of base level vacant Group-'B \& C' posts by way of direct recruitment under the Revenue Administration. 

1. Empowered Committee meeting was held on $22^{\text {nd }}$ February 2024 under the Chairmanship of Principal Secretary to Government, Finance Department and in presence of all the members of the Empowered Committee. The Committee discussed the matter on grant of permission for filling up of base level vacant posts of RI, ARI \& Amin meant for direct recruitment in 30 districts. The sanctioned strength, number of vacancies in each category of posts and the numbers of posts proposed to be filled up by way of direct recruitment is enclosed as Annexure-A.

The posts proposed to be filled up by way of direct recruitment primarily relates to filling up of 296, 572 \& 546 numbers of vacant posts of RI, ARI \& Amin respectively existing in all the 30 districts under the Revenue Administration. This is required for efficient, prompt \& timely delivery of public Services in Revenue Administration.

## 2. Comments of consulting Departments-

As per the opinion given by the ST \& SC Development Department the reservation of vacancies for the ST, SC \& SEBC has been appropriately computed.

The Additional Secretary, SSEPD Department participating in the meeting opined that the proposal for PWD reservation might be sent for vetting to their Department.

The views of SSEPD Department regarding the number of vacancies to be reserved for PWDs in their respective districts while filing online requisition shall also be intimated to the Collectors.


## 3. Recommendations of the Empowered Committee-

After detailed discussion, Empowered Committee have agreed and accorded approval for filling up of the base level posts meant for direct recruitment which are as follows:
i. RI- 296 numbers of posts
ii. ARI- 572 numbers of posts
iii. Amin- 546 numbers of posts

The base level Group-'B \& C' vacant posts meant for direct recruitment shall be filled up following the relevant recruitment rules and provisions of ORV Act.
